
Dear Sam,

I would like to thank you and your crew starting with Cameron Miller, Jim Glefke (tree removal), Soulliere Stone (brick walkway), Trost Irrigation and the men that stripped the sod from our yard, re-graded it, and replaced the sod. We are retired and on a tight budget and knowing the grading in our front yard was incorrect, we knew we would need to do some of the work to help alleviate the costs. Cameron worked with us to keep the costs down. We originally met with Cameron last August. Our initial problem involved a neighbor that was less than co-operative. Their trees were invading our yard causing additional issues. Cameron understood our issues and walked us through the steps for having the neighbors trees trimmed. He sensed our reluctance and the need for the cautionary approach we wanted to take so as not to get this neighbor upset. Per Cameron's advice, we hired a lawyer (to handle our neighbor), had our lot surveyed, and waited until the cold winter to have their trees trimmed. They didn't like the trees being trimmed but, they couldn't do much when it was done by the "book". Again, working with Jim Glefke at Cameron's recommendation, the trimming was executed without issue along the lot line. Their trimming of our oak tree in the center of our yard also proved to be a great improvement in the overall shape of the tree. When spring tried to break, we used Round-Up on our lawn in an effort to kill off the lawn and unwanted vegetation. In the interim, Soulliere and his crew came in, installed our brick walkway to the front door in two days. One week later, your crew came in removed the sod one day, corrected our grading and laid the sod the next day. Trost checked in several times to make sure the sprinkler system was adjusted correctly. Today our grass is green, healthy and our grade is correct. It looks great and we are extremely pleased.

My husband and I were so impressed with Cameron, United Lawnsapes and the other contractor's efficiency. Everyone did what they said they were going to do. Cameron always kept his appointments, never cancelling or putting us off. He was there during the process to make sure we understood what was going to happen as well as represent our concerns to the crews.
